Annual Exam

The annual exam is in my possession from the NHIAA. I have shared this with our Rules Interpreter, Terry Dostie. to review for incorrect questions. Upon review, he decided to replace the final 3 questions and insert new ones. The final 3 were related to score keeping only. I have submitted the replacement questions to the NHIAA. Terry and I decided to have the test released on Monday, February 6, 2023 (the day after our first interpretation meeting) and have a close date of April 7, 2023. The Board agreed to change that end to April 3, 2023. The test is 50 questions and an 80% grade is required to pass. There are 2 attempts to pass and the test is not scrambled, meaning everyone will see the test in the same order.

April 22 Holman D1 Games

This is the day set up and sponsored by "Adrenaline" which is a tournament atmosphere event with 4 games. I have decided to take this day and run it like a "Pretournament" and will all be worked with 3-man crews. I have taken an experienced 3 man umpire with tournament to work the plate along with 2 "newer" to that type atmosphere that were suggested by assignors as tournament ready and possibly in a final. The sponsor is paying for the 3rd umpire.

NHIAA Survey on Time Limits

I have not received back the results of a survey the NHIAA was doing to gauge the feel for putting time limits of 2:15 on all sub-varsity games. My hope is that by our annual meeting, that will be adopted by the baseball committee.
